The structure of the day is intended to be somewhat relaxed and playful, allowing participants to experience practical, therapeutic techniques from an "out of the box" perspective. - •growing the Seven Seeds of Spirit in your own garden

From Business 40 (East or West) take the Silas Creek Parkway North exit (following the signs to Wake Forest University). Continue on Silas Creek Parkway for approximately 3 miles.
